Dear Bill,

Here are two new Secret Service documents.

One shows that Earlene Roberts kept telling the same suppressed story, sometimes with more detail. It fits well with Hoover's dating of the Tippit shooting before the government knew the time schedule to make its story tenable. And before Oswald could have done it.

The second represents the impossible - that all TV nets destroyed their most important assassination footage.

Dr. Perry held only one press conference. He had Kemp Clark take over the one he had scheduled for the next day. His one was the first after the assassination, when it was announced the President was dead. On 11/22/63.

Almost certainly all net footage of that time was film.

Almost certainly none was destroyed. It was much too important.

I have quotes of what Dr. Perry said. It is exactly as I say in Post Mortem.

JFK was shot from front.

Which is why the film was suddenly non-existent when the government decided to say otherwise.

I tell you he said this, and not he alone among the medical people there, not alone on my own proofs or their statements to me. I have but am not at liberty to use the transcript.

I've been sent a copy of the National Examiner. It is a ripoff, typical of Lane. He did not get it under FOIA, although he has been handing it out like calling cards. He got it from Post Mortem.

I look back and wonder over all the stories I've proposed that the Enquirer did not see. This is one, of 1974 I think.

However, "a missile" does not have to be a bullet. More likely it isn't. Ordinarily.
