Dear Jim,

Jim Schmitt, the man who discovered the Drennan-Brown FBI report, has come up with material that relates to it. Paul Hock has sent me a copy of which the best copy I can make is attached. You will recall that a week ago we mentioned Milteer briefly.

In the event this has not attracted your attention, note that Milteer's trip just before the assassination included New Orleans. I have marked this part.

Please also note his acquaintance with and liking for one R.E. Davis of Dallas. Before asking Penn about this, I wonder if Boxley has done anything on it? I do not want to cross wires.

As of now I expect to spend some time this week at the Archives and will check this further, for it fits with the new book, COUP D'ETAT and I will be adding this and whatever else is available. Part of this file is withheld. I am hoping with this file as a beginning to be able to locate the one I say more than two years ago and that the Archives now cannot locate.

From internal evidence, it would seem that the FBI's source was the Miami police informant.

As of the end of last week, the official transcript of the first proceeding on Drennan's extradition was not yet available. I am trying to get it and will let you know when I have it.
