Hate Pamphlets Probe Requested

LELAND, Miss. (AP)—Leland residents concerned over recent circulation of hate pamphlets here, apparently prompted a request that the FBI look into the matter.

The three-page pamphlets urge white citizens to join the National State Rights Party and attacked school desegregation, calling those who accepted integrated schools "limousine liberals with warped and fuzzy minds."

"We whites are right and our Jew and Negro enemies are wrong," states an essay in the pamphlet signed by party chairman J.B. Stoner.

Leland schools recently were integrated under a federal court order and, in contrast to some other state schools, white enrollment has been high and public support of the schools has remained strong.
