When I was recently in New Orleans I learned from Ed Devenport, WNL radio, that John Naylor, who had been a cameraman for WVUE-TV, had for some time, when Ferrie was operating across the lake, spent weekends there, saying he was going to take guerilla training and pictures of it. Naylor usually carried his TV equipment in the back of his car. On Friday's he'd add other photo equipment and take off. He should have valuable pictures of whatever camp he went to, Ferrie's or another.

Naylor was married to a Hattiesburg, Miss. girl. He is now married to a woman from Minneapolis. They have two children, hers or theirs. He is said to have had some odd jobs after leaving New Orleans, less desirable than that of a TV cameraman, then to have worked for KSTP, which is in Minneapolis, and now to have his own photo shop, doing color movies, etc. It is called (approx) "Studio 118".

The more recent information was obtained for me by Ed from Al Wester (private home phone 282-1504) who says he spoke to Naylor in about late September or early October of this year. Presumably Wester is or can be in touch with Naylor.

I suggest that if he has any such pictures they might be of great value. I have no knowledge about his own involvements and whether they were or he might consider they were culpable or in any way reprehensible.
