Dear Harold:

Schulman is sort of Louisville's resident intellectual. He used to write for the Courier. He is sort of semi-retired, writes for a weekly sometimes. About 65 or 70. Seemed nice to me. Sort of an oldfashioned liberal sort.

Got to have some fun out of the U.S. Senate this weekend. On Friday night, Sen. Chris Dodd was in Louisville for a fundraiser. He went to law school here. He was on the Friday night show, about 11pm. After the fundraiser. He called in and I had asked a question that they wrote down and asked him. Which was, "You were on the HSCA and do you have an opinion if JFK was killed by Oswald alone or by a conspiracy. His answer, nearly verbatim, was, "We looked at a lot of evidence, and there were a lot of unanswered questions, but at the end of the day, when all the evidence was in, I feel that Oswald killed JFK alone." So I guess he learned a lot!

The other was funny. I listened to the NASCAR race, stock cars, from New Hampshire. Sen. Bob Dole was one of the guests. He was talking about how much he liked racing, and so forth, when Eli Gold, the voice of NASCAR, broke in and said "We have to put you on hold, Senator, a round of pit stops is coming up!"
