I'm awaiting a forecast of thawing weather.

If you knew when you will be down please let me know. I'll arrange either to be home that day or to make it that day and come back with you, if you can come here, as I'd like. There are things I want to show you.

Maybe you might even have some ideas about what I can do with them other than give them away.

If you can, please get the ~~xxxx~~ names of all the Invaders at the Lorraine 4/4/68 from them and from Bailey the names of these he gave the FBI as checking out about 5:45 that same day.

He did. And he does not have to worry about giving them now. They are blacked out in what I've received. I am confident each is an Invader. But he does not have to worry about you or me and he does know he gave this to the FBI, which fails to state its source in what I have as of now.

On the committee, Sprague is in trouble. He is one of the two I went after. The other has already departed. There is no chance it will get its appropriation. I have a hunch I knew Fauntroy's men-source on the Portugal connection, which has to be something else. I think there is a first-rate story in this. I also think you should not get bogged down in it.
