Please allow me to thank you for dispatching the seventy three (73) Xeroxed sheets of spectrographic and neutron activation haw data on artifacts and the assassination of the late President John F. Kennedy which I had requested of Director Kelley by certified letter 792591, received by him February 20, 1975.

Enclosed is personal check number 7305 payable in the amount of forty two dollars and sixty cents (\$12,60) for this service. Also enclosed is a Xerox copy of my Western Union cable of one hundred dollars (\$100,00). You had advised me of the complex problem of making refunds; after receipt of the check for the exact amount you may be able to return the Western Union payment intach.

Dear Mr. Shea:

Many thanks for your letter of April 16, 1975; my delay in answer is because of being away in consultation with some atomic physicists regarding the interpretation of the neutron activation data generated by Mr. Gallager on the artifacts from the assassimation of the late President John F. Kennedy.

As you can see from the enclosure I have sent Mr. Bresson my personal check in the exact amount of \$12.60 to cover costs of search and Xeroxing as advised by Chief Kelley on April 15, and have requested Mr Bresson to return the one hundred dollars (\$100.00) advanced by Western Union wire a few days earlier. I had by error addressed Mr. Bresson at the Justice Department.

There remains my sixth request sent by Western Union Telegraph from Chacago and received by Mr. Kelley two days prior to my letter request for the other five items. It reads:

> "Asvise amount of metal removed from each exhibit for chemical and or neutron activation analysis and amount of each remaining and permit me to submit any remaining to neutron activation

analysis".

This is in reply to your letter to me dated April 21st, with enclosures, and your letter of the same date directed to Mr. Bresson of the FBI's Freedom of Information Act Unit, which enclosed your check in the amount of \$42.60.

With regard to the information requested in your mailgram dated February 18th, and subsequently discussed telephonically with Mr. Bresson, we have determined that except for small amounts of each specimen which were removed for spectographic and/or neutron activation analysis examinations, the specimens referred to were turned over to the National Archives and are in the custody of the Archivist. The amounts of material removed for preparation of the specimens for examinations were not recorded nor were the remaining weights recorded.

I trust the above information will be of assistance to you.
