I went over, with Mr. Betzner (sr), some of the errors in Harold's book regarding his son's participation. Of course, Harold did not make all of the errors.


Mr. Betzner (Jr) lived at 5922 Velasco and not 2922 Velasco. The camera is a Vollenda which Mr. Betzner (Sr) purchased in Germany during the depression. It is quite an expensive and advanced camera for that time and is still in excellent condition. It was made in Germany by Eastman Kodack's branch and has a Zeiss lens and takes split negatives on 127 film, not 120.

There seems confusion in the three pictures. The first picture has the jail for the background. Mr. Betzner wrote his son and asked him some specific questions:

1. Deckers office developed and returned negatives to you?
(Ans) The Sheriff's office developed the film and gave it, the negatives, back before it was dark. I do not remember if it was about 1:30 PM or 4:30 PM.
2. Did F.B.I. see them that day? If not when?
(Ans) I don't know
3. Who kept any prints?
(Ans) To my knowledge no one kept prints. The Sheriff's office never said that they had kept any. -- To my memory.
4. Were you questioned by F. B. I. other than on 22nd? If so when?
(Ans) I do not even recall being questioned at all by the FBI.

Mr. Betzner showed me this letter with the questions and his son's answers. We have not filed our answer of rebuttal but hope to do so this month and may get the suit off the ground shortly afterward.
