Marine Unit Ends

San Clemente Duty

CAMP PENDLETON, Calif., Aug. 19 (AP)—The Marine Corps has withdrawn its 28-man patrol from the boundary of former President Nixon's San Clemente estate, a spokesman said.

A Camp Pendleton official announced Sunday that the order ending the patrol had come two days earlier from the Pentagon.

The unit had patrolled the southern border of the Nixon home, which borders the Marine base, and was available to assist the Secret Service during the Nixon presidency.

Secret Service agents continue to provide security for the former President.
