

Hunt-blackmail. RW speech 8/15/73

"...that one of the defendants was currently attempting to blackmail the White House by demanding payment of \$120,000 as the price of not talking about other activities unrelated to Watergate, in which he had engaged."

Dean, etc

On April 30 Nixon said that because of "new information that came to me on March 21, I personally assumed responsibility for coordinating extensive new inquiries into the matter, and I personally ordered those conducting the investigations to get all the facts and report them directly to me."

On 8/15 he said nothing about "personally" ordering "those conducting the investigations" to do anything at all between March 21 and April 15. He said instead that first he had turned to Dean, then to Ehrlichman, and that in late March he had told Ehrlichman to tell Kleindienst to report directly to N on anything showing WH WG involvement, RW did not even suggest that he spoke to K1 "personally.", his words of 4/30. Compare K1 test. The second version followed K1 and Petersen's testimony, Ervin.
