Daughter Says

INDIANAPOLIS, Aug. 20 (AP)—Julie Nixon Eisenhower said today her father's talk of resignation in the depths of Watergate depression was "a private conversation" in the family and he now has no thought of stepping down until his term ends in 1977.

Mrs. Eisenhower, addressing a ladies day program at the Indiana State Fair, drew applause when she said, "Watergate is not typical of politics as long as there are people like you who want to be for anyone who stands up for good."
