

Memorandum 8/28/74 Shuprio, ^{Stephen} Sachs, Steven Schulman
Shuprio - no prosecution to "bring us together"
Sachs - up to Bronski with only one factor that
"Union was President" which he thinks "does not
mean that he (Kym) should not be prosecuted"
"If he were prosecuted it might be made divisive".
Schulman, Kozak's lawyer "reconciliation might be
better achieved by Mr. N's not having
immunity."
