Q. I can't believe that instead of billing Richard Nixon for legal fees owed by him, the Washington law firm of Miller, Cassidy, Larroca & Lewin directly bills Rabbi Korff, who pays the Nixon bills from publicly contributed fees. What's the story?—Carl Franklin, Hempstead, N.Y.

A. From *The Washington Post* of Nov. 25, 1974—
"Korff said the legal bills are being submitted directly to the fund [President Nixon Justice Fund] by Herbert Miller Jr., Mr. Nixon's lawyer. 'I have an understanding with Mr. Nixon,' Korff said in a recent interview. 'I get the bills and I pay them.'" Rabbi Baruch Korff paid \$30,000 to the Miller law firm on Oct. 4, 1974, and another \$30,000 on Nov. 13, 1974, the story said.
