Nixon Adviser On D.C. Named

Dana Mead, a former staff member of the White House domestic council, has been named associate director of the domestic council and has officially taken over the duties of White House chief adviser on District of Columbia affairs.

Mead succeeds Egil Krogh, who moved from the White House to the Department of Transportation, and then resigned after he was implicated in the alleged burglary of the office of Pentagon papers defendant Daniel Ellsberg's psychiatrist.
