

Caller Describes Nixon

As 'Down in Dumps'

MILWAUKEE, Aug. 29 (AP)
—An aide to Rep. Glenn Davis, (R-Wis.), says former President Nixon seemed "depressed" in a telephone conversation with Davis.

Press aide Bob Halsey said Davis called Mr. Nixon from a corner telephone booth Monday after Mr. Nixon attempted to reach him at his offices in Washington and Menomonee Falls. Halsey said Davis had been out campaigning.

"It was a straight personal type of call," said Halsey, who described Mr. Nixon as seeming "isolated" in the phone call. He quoted Davis as saying Mr. Nixon was "down in the dumps and wanted to talk to old friends and see how things were."
