The following investigation was conducted by SAs Robert S. Gavanaugh and Richard A. Carr et LUBBOCK, Texas, on 11-25-63.

Mr. Calvin OREEN was interviewed at his home, 2804 CORNELL. OREEN advised that he has lived in Lubbook, on and off, for several years and is employed as a plumber. CREEN has recently moved back to LUZZOCK from IRVING, Texas.

GREEN stated that at the end of August 63 he was engaged in a poker game at the home of Louis TANNER, 1620 MURSKRY Rd., IRVING, Texas. GREEN alledges that at this poker game, one of the participants, BILL(LMU), had in his possession the wifle that was used in the assassination of the Freeddent in Dallas, Texas. Bill had put the weapon up as security on a bet in the game and had won the weapon back. GREEN stated that when he saw the weapon on television he know it was the one that he had seen originally at the poker game.

GREEN also stated that two of the other players in the game were Lee C6-WALD and Jack RUBY . He did not know either of these men by name but recognized both men when they appeared on television after the assassination of the Presi-

In addition, GREEN advised that an other eard game had taken place at the home of TANNER, about a week subsequent to the initial game. This time BILL(LMU) showed up at the game and placed a pawn ticket in the pot stating that he had gotten \$30 for the rifle at a local pawn shop. The game was in progress when Jack RUBY showed up and allegedly "took the pot". However, the pawn ticket was won by Louis TANNER. After this OREEN never saw the gun again until it appeared en television. CREEN stated he could tell it was the came gum, or he was pretty sure it was, because of the leather band on the bottom of it.

This information was reported by telephone to the Dellas Division on 11-25-63. Supervisor Kenneth HOWE, flu deak, advised that the information should be placed in a memo and forwarded to the Headquarters City.
