The Best Ears Of Our Lies

Dear Sir:
 I am the "ex-intelligence agent" Ron Rosenbaum mentioned in his piece, "The Assassination Labyrinth" (Voice, March 8), and I would like to offer a couple of footnotes to his article. The "new breed of lie-detecting device" Mr. Rosenbaum mentioned is called the Psychological Stress Evaluator. It detects the same kind of stress that can be observed with the conventional polygraph, but it requires only a tape recording of the subject's voice, and not physical connections, such as blood pressure cuffs or pneumographic tubes. Because of this, it is a unique tool for historical research.

The principal reason I did not run the Dallas police tape through the PSE was not that it was a fourth generation tape, but because this recording of conversations between a police dispatcher and the patrol cars did not contain any disputed testimony. Actually, the PSE works quite well on fourth generation tapes, although I did not know this at the time of Mr. Rosenbaum's visit. Recently,

I ran a tape of Clifford Irving, made before his conviction, in which he describes one of his interviews with Howard Hughes. The PSE showed deception very clearly on the original tape, and did equally well on a fourth generation copy I made in order to test this very point.

Since Mr. Rosenbaum's visit, I have collected the recorded testimony of 24 persons having knowledge of the JFK assassination, ranging from eyewitnesses to members of the Warren Commission, and including the pathologist who conducted the autopsy. I have processed the tapes and analyzed the results. A picture of what really happened in Dallas has begun to emerge. It agrees with neither the Warren Report
