

JFK Aide O'Donnell Ill

CLEVELAND, July 13 (UPI) —Former Kennedy administration presidential aide Kenneth P. O'Donnell was listed in fair condition at St. Vincent Charity Hospital today with an unspecified illness.

A spokesman for the hospital said the doctor in charge of O'Donnell's case was running tests and would not comment on the nature of his patient's illness.

O'Donnell, 48, who served as appointments secretary for President John F. Kennedy, came here Thursday for a cocktail party in his honor. An

autograph party for O'Donnell's new biography of the late President, "Johnny, We Hardly Knew Ye," also had been scheduled.

O'Donnell, who lives in Boston, was admitted to the hospital Thursday afternoon.
