When I can, I will be providing you copies of these pages, for there is much of interest in them. I would also prefer no further distribution, ~~xxx~~ including discussion, for I pain special uses, as in court, etc.

This is merely to note that I have this and the items of those of interest that, on hasty reading, seem most interesting.

They deal with a few excisions from the record but raise questions about many. Among those not eliminated, as was the case with O'Sullivan's reference to Ferrie, are references to alleged homosexuality.

There is a rather large number of references to the alleged criminal records of people and assorted details of their personal lives (like the reason for the Paines separation).

Profanity. Dell's favorite word is "bitch".

In some cases the entries are masked, as one to Rruly. III;257, an apparent characterization of Jack Dougherty. But it is in a possible reference to possible homosexuality, and if this is the case, the practice is not followed with consistency. There is one on Steele, Sr., though this isn't indicated, X73, where there appears no "deletion" indication and, on hasty reading, none would seem appropriate.

The medical stuff here is of particular interest to me, as you will know from your knowledge of EM ("Mary" note, plus page numbered 6)

Question (7) "Is there any reason not to publish S AFain's reference to FBI informants in Fort Worth and Dallas?". There is no indication of deletion, no reason to believe there really was one, but Fain did not mention Dallas.

There appears to be uncertainty (8), "Does the record contain a statement from each and every federal intelligence and security agency expressly stating that Oswald was never employed by it as any type of agent? "

Wierdies (9) X;45,47, "Have Mr. Bringuier's assertions regarding Communist association and Castro's remarks been negated on the record?" These pages contain no references to Communists, so possibly alleged pro-Castro and Communists are as indistinguishable to Pollak as to Bringuier.

Some page: nothing like having sworn statements that are undated, or like not proclaiming their "js" character.

"Where did Oswald get a check for \$189?", p. 10, ref to 10H335, Hutcheson/
Anyone able to cite the answer?
