Thank you for your letter of 9/9 and the three enclosed pages.

On each of these three pages there is withhelding. In no instance is any authority for the withhelding cited. There is no claim to any exemption in your letter. This therefore is a de facto denial and I here ith appeal this denial. I do it through you in the hope of avoiding what will without your compliance become burdensome to the peartment as well as to me.

I also remind you that from the date on the one document that bears a date and from the content of the other two pages these are past the 15-year rule in historical cases, as the attorney General has held this to be.

Even declassification authority and date are not indicated.

These pages are, quite obviously, incomplete. It is not possible to determine with certainty whether they are parts of three asparate records or not. My requests include all records on or relating to the JFK assassination and Lee Harvey Oswald. They therefore include these complete records.

Through the extensive and unexplained obliterations and despite the other withholdings it is apparent that while these pages relate to "swald what remains of them refers to
him not as Oswald but as "LEE." This would seem to require that there be other records
relating to this, if only to correct or explain it. They are within my requests and I would
appreciate copies of them also.

It seems to me that in this instance the "epartment has not acted in accord with the statement of FOIA/PA policy by the Attorney General this past Way. That it has not and intends not is indicated by the failure to respond by the office of which you are part to what I have written and asked for under my other requests, particularly for all records on or about me under the Privacy Act. While compliance by other agencies is as reluctant and incomplete as that by State, it is showing me increasingly that State has not made a good-faith search with due diligence, that records not explained or for which exemptions are claimed are being withheld, and that any kind of search has to have shown the existence of these other records. While I believe I have appealed that de facto denial, if I have not or if it has been mislaid this is that appeal. I would hope that the Department would not want this matter to go to court and that it would prefer to avoid this by full and honest compliance. If you have no familiarity with that matter I indicate the nature of the continuing withholdings by telling you that they include newspaper stories and non-secret "epartmental regulation. This seems to be pretty ridiculous to me. I hope it does to you and to the Department. How ever, there are other withholdings of which I here specify but one new one, the files of the late John Peurifoy and records relating th Departmental appropriations for the time in question, circa 1947. These are, I believe, interrelated. I also believe they will lead to other records of some of which I have specific knowledge.

For my part I would prefer to avoid wasting the time and cost of having to do more than ask the Department for these records. While for conditions of health getting to Washington now presents problems for me if the Department wants to discuss this I will make an effort to accommodate it.


