Dear Sir:

In a letter dated March 6, 1970 from the Assistant Director (see attached), I was told that Lee Harvey Oswald had " never received any training from the Marine Corps in the Russian Language ".

In 1974, the National Archives released a document which consist of pages 127-212 of a transcript for the January 27, 1964 proceedings of the Presidents Commission on the Assassination of Presidents Kennedy (see attached). On page 192 of that document, it is stated that Oswald attended the " Monterey School of the Army " (Defense Language Institute, Presidio of Monterey). In view of this recent revelation, the letter of March 6, 1970 would no longer seem to be satisfactory for my purposes and I would appreciate having this particular issue now clarified.

Therefore, I again would ask your office if Oswald ever received any language training while a member of the Marine Corps, including that which may have been given by instructors from one or more of the several military services and not necessarily limited to a unit housed on a Marine installation. If it is now determined that such was the case, I would like photocopies of the relevant documents for which I will be glad to pay you.
