Sciambra interviewed Miguel Mariano Cruz in Baton Rouge, where he was, apparently, at the Univ., in 1967.

Cruz then claimed to have seen LHO handing out his leaflets outside the Maison Blanche (remember, Liebeler said Maison Blanche to Briuguier and Briuguier said no, Ward's Discount House, where he used to work-and remember the suppressed FBI report IH thinks is withheld only because of Quiroga's fear for his father?).

Even more interesting is it that Cruz also told Sciambra that he then saw a heavy-set Latin taking pictures of it, and that LHO had a helper. This was 2/9/63.

If that photographer was not doing this for the government, is it not strange that these pictures have never surfaced?

Perhaps the index has already been checked and Cruz does not appear on the withheld Quiroga pages. But if it does, is this not an interesting possibility? For we know the FBI got the Martin (Mpls) film and never let the Warren Commission know; that it got the Doyle film and not only didn't let the Commission know but filed five different reports, as I recall, in not one of which did it mention that it then had this film.

It would seem to be a not unreasonable suspicion that something shows in these films the FBI did not want known. Or somebody.

Cruz also said he sat next to Oswald in the police car and Oswald was mute; that at the police station he also preserved complete silence when they were together. Oswald? How unlike all other accounts of him.

By communication dated July 31, 1964, the Latent Fingerprint Section, Identification Division of the Federal Bureau of Investigation advised that one latent fingerprint had been developed on a yellow-colored leaflet entitled "Hands Off Cuba." This leaflet was designated as Specimen D-234.

One latent fingerprint was also developed on a white-colored leaflet entitled "The Truth About Cuba Is In Cuba." This leaflet had been designated as Specimen D-235.

The two latent fingerprints were not identical with fingerprints of LEE HARVEY OSWALD, deceased, FBI Number 327925D.

The two leaflets described above were obtained from Lieutenant ROY ALLEMAN of the New Orleans Harbor Police, New Orleans, Louisiana, on July 21, 1964. Investigation concerning these leaflets is reflected in a communication dated July 22, 1964, at New Orleans, Louisiana.
