She advised that she approached OSWALD and asked if she could help him. She stated that he replied, ."I just want to look." She stated that he again went to the section where the frames were displayed and began to look at the 8" by 10" frames. She stated that she again approached him and asked, "Are you interested in 8" by 10" frames"? She stated that he replied, "I just want to look." She stated that he then left the store. She advised that OSWALD seemed to her to be a rather irritable man who impressed her as being a little obnoxious. She advised that OSWALD did not at that time ask her if any positions were available at the studios. She stated that she cannot state definitely that OSWALD was or was not in the store on September 13, 1963, because she did not commence her own employment in the store until September 14, 1963.
