If delay could assure that nothing else could happen, Hoover assured it. He forwarded September reports in the case of The False Oswald in November. The reader is referred to the text for analysis of the documents. With this file, that cannot be done adequately in brief footnotes. Despite the contrary pretenses of the FBI, these reports, meaning what it chose to say of what answers it got to only those questions it elected to ask, actually confirm Mrs. Odio's
