ALEX WALLER, City Night Editor, Times-Picayune, telephonically contacted New Orleans at 7:47 p.m., 11/26/63, and stated that a WINONA McKENNON, a "stringer" for the Wall Street Journal, who he believes resides at 731 Dumaine Street, telephone JACKSON 2-0066, had contacted the newspaper and advised some person had told her that LEE HARVEY OSWALD had hung out at the Dixie Bar of Music in the Quarter and was known as a "male prostitute".

WALLER stated he was furnishing this information for whatever it was worth.
