Legal Attache Bates telephoned via cost-free Defense facilities from London at 8:55 a.m., 11/25/63, to report that British Alien Registration records indicate that Lee Harvey Oswald, born 10/18/39, had visited England. Oswald, bearing U. S. Passport 1733242 issued at Los Angeles, California, 9/10/59, arrived in Southampton, England, by ship from LeHavre, France, 10/9/59. He stated he intended to take a one-week vacation in England before going to school in Switzerland. He had \$700 in U. S. Money in his possession and furnished no London address, indicating he would stay at a hotel. He left England by air on 10/10/59 bound for Helsinki, Finland. No other information is available.

ACTION:

Bates stated he would make inquiry in Finland when he made his next trip there, which will be in about a week, unless advised to the contrary.
