On this date Mr. JOHANN RUSH, News Department, WDSU TV, 520 Royal Street, made available to reporting Agents six photographic prints which he had enlarged from some 16 mm. motion picture film he took on August 16, 1963, in front of the International Trade Mart. RUSH said one of the individuals in these photographs is LEE HARVEY OSWALD and he believed the man wearing Burmuda shorts was a person named STEEL.

RUST pointed out one person in several of the prints (who he identified with an "X") who appears to be holding some handbills in his hand and is wearing dark trousers, a white shirt, and a dark tie. RUSH said throughout the entire filming of this scene, this person did not distribute handbills as OSWALD and STEEL were doing.

RUSH said that when he arrived at the scene OSWALD was standing in front of the building alone and RUSH believed he asked OSWALD when the latter was going to start distributing handbills. RUSH believed OSWALD replied that he would start as soon as two other associates came to that location to assist him.
