SUBJECT:

LEE HARVEY OSWALD

I interviewed Dr. LEGGIO at his office on Wednesday, March 27, 1968 at 4:00 p.m.

DR. LEGGIO stated that he had seen MARINA OSWALD pushing her baby up and down Magazine Street in a stoller.

DR. LEGGIO said that he had also seen OSWALD walking on Magazine Street and some times OSWALD was walking in the direction of Gogreve's Bar.

DR. LEGGIO said he never saw MARINA and OSWALD together, although he thought that both lived in the same building.

DR. LEGGIO never saw anyone visit OSWALD and he never saw OSWALD ride off in a car.

DR. LEGGIE says he never saw OSWALD with a gun or any other weapon.

DR. LEGGIO's opinion of OSWALD was "he just seemed to be keeping to himself".

DR. LEGGIO was interviewed by the FBI shortly after the assassination and he said he told them exactly what he told me.

NOTES :

From the layout of Dr. Leggio's office, it would be very difficult to observe anyone on Magazine Street as all the windows facing the street are curtained and have Venetian blinds.

Dr. Leggio was cooperative, and offered his help in the future if it became needed.
