RE NEW ORLEANS TEL TO BUREAU DECEMBER ONE SIX LAST  
CONCERNING ITEMS IN ADDRESS BOOK OF SUBJECT.

ORLANDO ~~PIEDRA~~, A CUBAN EXILE WITH RESIDENCE IN NEW  
ORLEANS, INTERVIEWED DECEMBER EIGHTEEN AT FORT LAUDERDALE, FLA.  
HE WAS PARTNER WITH JOSEPH B. ~~NAMER~~, CUBAN BORN U. S.  
CITIZEN, IN HISPANO AMERICAN DISCOUNT HOUSE LOCATED AT  
ONE ONE SEVEN CAMP STREET, NEW ORLEANS. PIEDRA SOLD OUT  
LAST APRIL AND NAMER OPERATED STORE UNTIL CLOSED DOWN LAST  
OCTOBER. PIEDRA DID NOT KNOW OSWALD. HE SUGGESTS THAT  
OSWALD PROBABLY LISTED LOCATIONS OF CUBAN EXILE STORES,  
NEW ORLEANS, WITHOUT NECESSARILY HAVING CONTACTS IN THEM.  
PIEDRA STATES NAMER MAY STILL RESIDE AT THREE THREE ZERO  
FIVE LOUISIANA, NEW ORLEANS.
