FORT WORTH, TEX. (UPI)--MRS. MARGUERITE OSWALD SAYS SHE WILL ASK PRESIDENT-ELECT RICHARD M. NIXON TO REOPEN THE CASE OF HER SON, LEE HARVEY OSWALD, THE ASSASSIN OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY.

MRS. OSWALD DISPLAYED A LARGE GLOSSY PRINT THURSDAY SHOWING A WHITE SHIRTED MAN STANDING IN THE DOORWAY OF THE TEXAS SCHOOL BOOK DEPOSITORY ON THE DAY PRESIDENT KENNEDY WAS SHOT.

"I WOULD HAVE TO SAY THIS MAN IN THE WHITE SHIRT IS LEE HARVEY OSWALD, AND THIS WAS TAKEN 10 MINUTES AFTER THE ASSASSINATION" MRS. OSWALD SAID.

ON THE BASIS OF THE PHOTO, SHE PROMISED TO ASK NIXON TO REOPEN HER SON'S CASE.

SITTING IN HER HOME BENEATH A PAINTING OF "WHISTLER'S MOTHER", MRS. OSWALD SHOWED NEWSMEN THE 8-BY-0 PRINT OF "MOTHER", MRS. OSWALD SHOWED NEWSMEN THE 8-BY-10 PRINT OF A PHOTOGRAPH TAKEN IN FRONT OF THE DEPOSITORY. SHE SAID A CLOCK IN THE ORIGINAL PICTURE SHOWED THE TIME AS 12:40 P.M. THE PRESIDENT WAS SHOT AT ABOUT 12:30 P.M.

SHE SAID THE NEW EVIDENCE WAS ENOUGH TO CAUSE NIXON TO REOPEN THE CASE TO CLEAR HER SON'S NAME.
