Police OK Beer License For Marina's Husband

Dallas, Tex., Sept. 29—(AP)—
County Judge W. L. Sterrett
says withdrawal of a police pro-
test has cleared the way for
issuing a beer license to Ken-
neth Jess Porter, husband of
Marina Oswald Porter.

This occurred after Porter
signed an affidavit stating his
Russian-born wife held no in-
terest in the bar and grill he in-
tends to open.

Vice squad officers had point-
ed out earlier that an alien could
not hold a license to sell beer.
Police said Porter agreed that
the license would be canceled if
he died.

Mrs. Porter's former husband
was Lee Harvey Oswald, named
by the Warren Commission as
the assassin of President John
F. Kennedy. Oswald was killed
two days later, Nov. 24, 1963, by
Jack Ruby, a Dallas nightclub
operator now under death sen-
tence.
