> The States-Item quoted Novel as saying he was working for the CIA in New Orleans. Part of his job, he contends, was to op erate the Evergreen Advertising Agency as a front for CIA communications.

> Novel prepared special radio commercials for use in the United States and Canada, the newspaper said, to alert agents to the date of the Bay of Pigs invasion. The key alert codes were "Star Christmas trees, and "holiday trees." Novels age ncy placed \$72,000 worth of radio time in 1960, the story said.
