RE: SECURE BIRTH RECORD OF ONE LEE HARVEY OSWALD

On February 28, 1968, Det. Simms went to the City Hall, Bureau of Vital Statistics, where he secured a copy of the birth record of one LEE HARVEY OSWALD. Det. Simms at this time learned that approximately eight to ten letters were written to the Bureau of Vital Statistics requesting copies of OSWALD's birth record by astrologists throughout the country. Also, one letter was written by the FBI requesting same. It should be noted that no copies of OSWALD's birth record was sent to anyone except the FBI.
