Dear WFFW,

Because you are the station in my area that carried last night's Pacifica program supposedly on the facts of the assassination of President Kennedy and because Pacifica violated its specific agreements with me, I send you the enclosed letter I have written to the producer.

I am merely informing you. I make no demands.

I do offer the opinion that for any station, particularly Pacifica, to cut off such information, or in plainer language, to suppress it, is both shocking and unconscionable.

I also believe that spending limited resources on what really rips off the public mind, misinforms and disinforms, is hardly in Pacifica's interest or that of its listeners.

The assassination was quite serious, as were its consequences. Public stations in particular ought to treat it responsibly and factually. Pacifica did not and it now appears without doubt never intended to. I regret this very much.
