Dear Mr. Keuch:

Enclosed is a sworn affidavit listing certain activities in which I was involved in during my association with the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the House Select Committee on Assassinations.

Also enclosed is a five page summary which details to some degree the activities which I was involved in under the direct supervision and instruction of these investigative agencies, the FBI and the HSCA.

I have tape recordings, documents, video tapes, witnesses, etc., all to prove my allegations that both these agencies acted at least unethically and probably illegally in their investigations into the death of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.

I hereby request that an investigation into the operations of these agencies, the FBI and HSCA, to determine if they acted improperly within their investigations of Kings death.

I have written numerous letters to various government officials and have received no replies other than an occasional letter stating that my allegations have no foundations. NO ONE has ever questioned any of my witnesses, seen my evidence, or for that matter shown any interest whatsoever. The agencies I am directing my allegations at have "investigated" and of course found them without foundation. Of course, it is easy to clear oneself of any charges when oneself is the Judge!

Once again, I ask for your help in assessing my evidence against the wrongful acts committed by these agencies.
