To Quin Shee from Hereld Weisberg, Ming assessination records 8/10/78 YDI Informer Liver Patterson

One of the items stolen from Jerry Ray and given to the Department via the House assessing comittee, allegedly, is a map of the jail in which James Earl Ray is. News accounts have it that this map is regarded by the FBI Director and the AD as of great significance. Early this morning I spoke to "arry Ray about this. He says he had no much map and, what I agree with, had no need for any such map. (ichually, in common with many others, he has photographs.)

Without in any vey downrading the skills of the FSI and its Lab, I think that with what is now involved in this entire matter it serves all responsible interests for a copy of this and other stolen material to be provided to me as rapidly as possible.

To further explain time, meaning the possibility that it was planted, and to add information for your staff, additional information follows.

While the published accounts have it that Patterson began spying on the EERP and the Ray family if not also defense in 1972, it is the & recollection of Jerry "sy that in fact it began during the 1970 campaign of J.B. Stoner of the MEER. This has it defense in time with J.B.Stoner's representation of James Earl Ray as well as with the defense of which Jim Levar and I were part.

There came a time during that earlier period when Patterson plied Jerry with considerable amounts of vodks, a drink with which Jerry was unfamiliar. During this drinking there came a point at which Jerry Pay, while incide with Patterson, suddenly had no awareness. 'S came to in a heavital, rather thoroughly beaten up, and what he did not tell we but I learned by other means, under an assumed name. Patterson's story to him was that they had left the residence in which they were and while driving along were set upon by others or that there was an accident. Heroule Poiret, ake Jerry, has a large capacity for believing what he is told.

I have two other sources on this beating up.

During the time that Patterson admittedly was an FSI informer he was able to make use of the St. Isuis police. One such occasion, and I have reports of more than one, was when Mrs. Albert (Carol) Papper had again changed her unlisted phone number in an effort to fend Patterson off and to reduce harmaning calls. This appears also to have happened during the time Patterson was wolding for the committee. On one occasions it frightened the Popper family.

After Jerry Ray lost conscioness the time Patterson checked him into the hospital under a fake name certain records Jerry had with him disappeared.

Because the flap potential of all of this is great, because reportedly the AG has been involved and because I do not suppose the Fill of flooding the AG with many distracting details prefering his concentration on a supposed escape map. I add that two women associated with Patterson have been talking. At least one was photographed recently with mark Lone in St. "ouis.

FRI reports not provided include its effort to pin a bank-robbery charge on Jerry via Bhonda Gibson, then a girl, as I believe I have told you. I have received no such reports. I have obtained further relevant information from a number of source; including Ms. Gibson, who was here from Bonday afternoon until about 10 p.m. and to whom I spake this norming about 1:50 a.m.

She was to have been an assessing counities witness on Tuesday. Jerry May drove her to Washington, stepping here. The counities was much occupied by other matters, ranging from the Patterson kickback to John Faul Spice, so it took no testimony from her. Significantly, I believe, especially in terms of the Add credibility of the map matter and the Add's time and attention taken by it, the counities also did not take any testimony from Jerry May about this although he was present throughout the entire day with Ma. Gibson.

Mr. Gibson will be home in a few days. If anyone has need to reach her, I know how this can be done. I am sure she will confirm being interviewed by the FRI.
