FLYNN, Senior Staff Photographer, "The Dallas Morning News", Dallas, Texas, and he acknowledged receipt of same on the original receipt given to him for these photos.

The contact strip print of photos made by Photographer WILLIAM ALLEN which was obtained from "The Dallas Times Herald" are not being returned inasmuch as they were not originals and "The Dallas Times Herald" did not request their return.
