Today, JOE BROWN, President, Dallas Cinema Association, phone FL 1-9911, ext 594, Dallas, Texas, telephonically advised as follows:

<sup>ANITA GEWIRTZ</sup> 6422 Walnut Lane, Dallas, advised BROWN that someone has been following her and harassing her. She also mentioned that her phone might be tapped.

BROWN said this has been reported to the Dallas PD but also wanted to the FBI to be aware of this because he felt it was in connection with the investigation of captioned matter by DA JIM GARRISON, New Orleans, La.

He stated he would instruct MRS. GWIRTZ to contact the phone company to have them check her phone to determine if it has been tampered with.
