As it relates to George Piazza, this cannot be true and those who wrote it had to know this. The language is carefully selected. I suggest you here consider whether the same is true of the Magyar report used in O in NO, of which you have a copy. You may recall Piazza died in a very strange crash, which also took the life of the FAA man who handled the Ferrie case.

Also strange is it that two of Ferrie's former friends wound up on the staff of the DA, Piazza and Moo. I am not suggesting anything sinister, merely a long coincidence. Piazza was well liked.

I think it entirely unlikely Piazza could have been so close to Ferrie for so long and had no reason even to suspect any homosexuality. Especially since it was hardly a secret from so many of the boys in the cadets and so many of them lived with Ferrie, which should have struck Piazza as strange. And all this is in retrospect.

I cannot say what this means, if it means anything, but I'd prefer not to assume that it means or can mean nothing. With the pattern of the source, one of the more likely suspicions is protection of federal interest or involvement. That dominates and connects, as the earlier memo to Bud of today indicates.
