Posner will also be getting a copy, for what its worth. A couple of the papers are pretty poorly written and could have had more documentation, but I believe the last three are especially good. I thought some of the others involved in perpetrating that fraud also deserved a letter. Loomis, Ambrose and Neuckerman will be getting copies of my cover letter to Posner. Ambrose will get a copy of the final quiz I gave my students.

I have read most of the reedited Hoax. I am sorry the publisher decided to cut out the chapters on Garrison and New Orleans. They are well-written and intriguing, even for someone like myself who has some familiarity with that aspect of the case. I also think some of the chapters cut out make pretty clear that Posner had substantial help. I was able to make that point for my students. The printed copy I have ends on p 768. The last chapter is XXXII "The Formable Man" (p 724) and the Epilogue which begins on p. 758.
