Dear Mr. Rehorst,

I do not mean to be short but I'm 81, in bad health and trying to continue the factual work that is rare in the field and to leave the best possible record for our history. I also try to respond because people do care. I hate to waste time writing letters to tell people what I went to so much trouble to do and publish books to tell them. I thus cannot now take time for some of your questions about which I did write at great length so the people could know.

There were fragments in JFK's body. My Post Mortem. They were not removed. The kind of ammo is irrelevant in that but there is solid evidence that some was not full-jacketed military ammo.

I can't take time for the Secret Service standards which I did not study but Fletcher Peruty's stuff on that is plain stuff.

At this point it is not generally accepted that the autopsy film was toyed with. You have been imposed upon by bullshit artists and conspiracy theorists who make those kinds of tales up. If that did happen, the proof has yet to surface. It is not in any of the books of those who have exploited and commercialized the assassination, ~~whatever~~ whatever it is whatever their contrary pretenses. Some like Livingstone, are not only ignorant—they are not even rational.

As you asked, I enclose the list of our books. One, Case Open, on Posner, about 1/5 of what I did, is in the stores.

- 1.) How did the witnesses who were at Parkland Memorial Hospital describe the wounds of John F. Kennedy?
- 2.) How did the witnesses at Bethesda Naval Hospital describe the wounds of John F. Kennedy?
- 3.) Is the fact that no bullets or identifiable fragments were found in the body of John F. Kennedy due to the type of ammunition used, the fact that they were removed, or some other reason which has yet to be put forth?
- 4.) Were any Secret Service standards concerning the protection of the president violated surrounding and during the time of the assassination? If so, what were they?
- 5.) At this point, it is generally excepted that the autopsy photographs and x-rays were forged. Briefly, what is the evidence on which this conclusion rests?
- 6.) How can I obtain copies you books Whitewash I, Whitewash II, and Photographic Whitewash?
