Yesterday I met briefly with the New Orleans lawyer handling the Bringuier suit for Dell, Saga and me. He is Bill Lucas, National Bank of Commerce Bldg. He has handled a number of free-press and consorship cases but was selected on a different basis by Dell: he is counsel to someone with whom they do business. I like him. There are overtones of ulterior purpose and outside interest in the Bringuier suit, which he also detects. In the course of telling me this he ~~has~~ also said that he was pretty certain Bringuier had been connected with anti-Semitic activities or the distribution of such literature.

If your people have anything on this, I'd like it rapidly. Also, the late Guy Banister of New Orleans, former G-man, 3rd-highest in N.O. Police Dept., propagandist for radical right, former weekly publisher, darling of White Citizens council, etc., anything on him that I can include in the appendix of my New Orleans book, with credit, that illustrates what he did and said.
