Dear Harold,

Excuse me for taking so long to respond to your note of March 26 in which you ask whether I had any information on Arnesto Rodrigues, Jr. who operates the Modern Languages Institute or on Mike Flatter who is described as an English Nazi. You also ask whether I have any information on Kent Courtney especially with respect to his so-called agents or informers, particularly in France. Finally, you ask for any information we might have on Phil Boatright, a poet.

I am turning your letter over to our friend here to see whether there is anything on any of these people. If so, I'll send along whatever we have. My guess is that while we have a good deal on Kent Courtney, we have nothing on any of the others and what we have on Courtney deals only with his publishing activities here, not with any connections he has in France.

Finally, I don't know whether we have any information on the George Lincoln Rockwell demonstrations staged in New Orleans in connection with the opening of the movie "Exodus". I do know that we did get some reports on the actual demonstrations and on his arrest. My recollection is that he was convicted. I'll let you know whether there is anything in our files which you can look at.

I hope you and Lil are fine and happy and doing well. I hope the financial problems are over. Since I got your letter spring has swelled at our summer place and we have been harvesting scads of daffodils. But recently we've had another cold snap that may well have damaged some of the fruit trees which were in blossom when we were up in Carmel last weekend.
