Stan Primmer, one of Hal Verb's original Bay Area assassinations group, was here Friday-Saturday.

He was some kind of water or sewer engineer but has switched to computers and now is with ARCO in LA. He was in, Brazil for a while some years ago and came back with a Brazilian wife.

He thinks Don Freed is some kind of agent. His reason: Don is allegedly working for Rand and has been seen there.

I don't recall if he said that he had seen Freed there or a trusted friend who may work there has. But the identification of Freed at Rand is positive, he says, and the inference that he works there pretty clear.

I had not heard anything like thisk before about Freed.

If one were to try to argue Stan's case, Executive Action is a direct steal from a SDECE black book; his stuff is pretty wild and thus counterproductive and misleading; and if he has done anything really worthwhile on the assassinations I have yet to hear of it.

On the other hand, what need or even use Rand would have had for him is not apparent.

Stan seems to think as a spy. Seems/ unlikely with Rand and with going there openly.
