**Postal Subversion**  
The House Select Committee on Government Operations has released a report which states that the Postal Service is being infiltrated by Communists and other subversives. The report, which is the first of a series, says that the Postal Service is a "prime target" for subversion because of its access to "secret and confidential information." It also states that the Postal Service is a "key link" in the communication system of the United States and that it is "vulnerable to attack by subversive forces." The report further states that the Postal Service is "being infiltrated by Communists and other subversives" and that this infiltration is "a serious threat to the national security." The report also states that the Postal Service is "being used as a tool for the dissemination of subversive propaganda" and that it is "being used to spread Communist propaganda throughout the United States."
