UNDERSHORTS SMALL IN SIZE WHILE T SHIRT IS LARGE.

NO BRAND LABEL ON UNDERSHORTS. T SHIRT HAS "JOCKEY" BRAND LABEL WHICH IS HELD FLAT WITH FOLDED PIECE THREE QUARTER INCH WIDE CELLOPHANE TAPE ABOUT ONE INCH LONG HAVING ONE CUT END AND ONE TORN END.
