

Received the following information from Sgt. Jack Green of the Arlington Police Department.

Sgt. Green stated SUND 62 was arrested November 27, 1963 at 2:04 A.M. in Arlington, Texas for not having a rear license plate and no valid Texas Drivers license. Sgt. Green stated arresting officer that Attorney Tom Howard had his rear license plate in his office.
