Reur 12/31, here today, it has to the best of my knowledge always been the position of the FBI that no reconstruction was by it. Are you referring to that by the Secret Service in referring to one in 12/64, meaning 63? I've not tried to keep track of those dates but I think the Commission's, using the FBI, was in 5/64. Now on that one, when we deposed Lyndal Shaneyfelt, he insisted that was not his and that he did what he did for the commission.

Now that you mention it, I do not recall any FBI records relating to any reenactment. So I cannot respond to your question about how the dot was placed.

If Jim Lesar, at AARC does not know, perhaps Kevin Walsh, who was on HSCA, might know. I think he can be reached through Lesar. His address is P.O.Box 15069, Washington 20005.

You do not <sup>know</sup> ~~say~~ where those people "working near the photos and x-rays" were or when it was. They could not have done any work on the photos at the hospital because they then had not been developed. As I say in WWII, Specter admits to having been shown a back picture by Tom Kelley of the SS. *at that time.*

I have made no effort to study either the photos or x-rays in part because I am not an expert and in part because that was not necessary in my work or to my approach. For me and for my writing it was enough that both the autopsists and the DJ panel headed by Fisher, while saying their reading of the X-rays supports the Commission, made records proving that the X-rays do the exact opposite, as I made clear in Post Mortem. I cannot conceive that anyone would run the great risks of phonying them up to evolve what destroys the official mythology.

On a second shot to the head, in Post Mortem I reported that the dispersal or those 40 dust-like fragments in the head is consistent with a shot from the front with different, soft ammo and that they are also impossible with a bullet made to conform with the Geneva convention, i.e., one of those MC's of the official mythology.

I do not know of anyone who has made the kind of search required for a definitive answer to your question about FBI records of reconstructions.
