I've checked the size of the Dallas "subversive" file on George deMohrenschildt.

It is about five inches, plus about an inch that I was able to require the FBI to reprocess.

I forgot to check the much smaller file of duplicates I copied from the main JFK assassination file, in which - told you there would like be some duplication, but in comparison it will be small.

The five inches includes a few file folders and is not compressed.

But perhaps this will give you an idea of the cost of copies.

The last I had done commercially in Frederick were seven cents a page. They might want a trifle more because the individual refords are stapled and that means more handling.

But if you want these records, I'll be glad to have them copied for you.

After we spoke I write Jim "esar reminding him of the copies he'd made of the pages of the Washington city directory that include the block of Penna. Ave., NW in which you are interested. Perhaps he'll be able to retrieve them.

He got to see them at a District of Columbia library, where if he can't find them someone might go and get copies for you, if you know someone of whom you can ask this.
