TELEPHONIC TO MIAMI MARCH 29, 1977.

AT 7:10 P.M., MARCH 29, 1977, MR. DALE BOCCA, FORMER CIA INTELLIGENCE OFFICER, TELEPHONICALLY CONTACTED WILLIAM O. BREWER, DEPUTY ASSISTANT DIRECTOR, INTELLIGENCE DIVISION, FBI, WHO ADVISED THAT MR. EDMUND J. EPPSTEIN (PW.), WHO IS AN OUTSTANDING INVESTIGATIVE REPORTER DOING RESEARCH UNDER A CONTRACT WITH READER'S DIGEST LOOKING INTO THE KENNEDY ASSASSINATION, TELEPHONICALLY CONTACTED BOCCA EARLIER IN THE EVENING. EPPSTEIN ADVISED THAT HE HAD BEEN INTERVIEWING ONE (FBI) DR. HORRENSCHILD. DR. HORRENSCHILD HAD BEEN DEPOSED BY THE WARREN COMMISSION. BOCCA BELIEVED THAT DR. HORRENSCHILD'S DEPOSITION WAS INCOMPLETE, INADEQUATE AND PROBABLY DID NOT REPRESENT DR. HORRENSCHILD'S COMPLETE KNOWLEDGE OF THE MATTER. EPPSTEIN DESCRIBED DR. HORRENSCHILD AND ON THE FIRST QUESTION OBTAINED "ORDINARY RELATIONS." FOLLOWING AN EARLY MORNING DEBRIEFING

TODAY, MARCH 29, 1977, EPPSTEIN RETURNED TO DE HOORNESCHILD'S RESIDENCE AND LEARNED HE HAD JUST COMMITTED SUICIDE.

ACCORDING TO EPPSTEIN, DE HOORNESCHILD LEFT WITH AN UNNAMED LAWYER IN DALLAS, TEXAS, A PHOTOGRAPH OF OSWALD HOLDING A RIFLE. THIS IS NOT BELIEVED TO BE A NEW PHOTOGRAPH, BUT ONE WHICH IT IS BELIEVED FBI HAS SEEN BEFORE. HOWEVER, ACCORDING TO DE HOORNESCHILD, THE PHOTO HE LEFT WITH THE LAWYER WAS ENGRAVED BY MARINA OSWALD WITH THE FOLLOWING: "LONG LIVES THE ASSASSINS." ROCCA HAS LONG BEEN OF THE OPINION THAT THE XERETTY ASSASSINATION WAS AN INTERNATIONAL ESPIONAGE CASE IN THAT OSWALD WAS USED BY THE SOVIETS. ROCCA ALSO RAISES THE QUESTION COULD THE DE HOORNESCHILD DEATH BE THE WORK OF THE SOVIETS AGAINST THEM SUICIDE.

MURK SHOULD IMMEDIATELY INTERVIEW EPPSTEIN REGARDING REVELATIONS MADE TO HIM BY DE HOORNESCHILD. MURK SHOULD USE WILLIAM O. CREGAR'S NAME AND EPPSTEIN'S TELEPHONE CONTACT WITH RAY ROCCA TO SUBSTANTIATE BONA FIDES FOR INTERVIEW. SINCE PROBABLY NO ONE IN THE MURK OFFICE IS COMPLETELY FAMILIAR WITH OSWALD CASE, TELL EPPSTEIN THAT, BUT THAT YOU WOULD LIKE TO HAVE ALL THE INFORMATION DE HOORNESCHILD FURNISHED EPPSTEIN WHICH COULD CONSTITUTE NEW REVELATIONS OR SUBSTANTIATE INFORMATION

HIAU SHOULD INTERVIEW EPPSTEIN, GET ALL THE INFORMATION HE HAS BEEN ABLE TO OBTAIN FROM DE KORENSCHILD, SEND IMMEDIATE TELETYPE IN TO FBIHQ, AND FBIHQ WILL EVALUATE TO DECIDE WHAT LEADS SHOULD BE GOT OUT FOR OTHER OFFICES INVOLVED.

BECAUSE OF THE POSSIBLE SIGNIFICANCE OF NEW REVELATIONS, EPPSTEIN SHOULD BE ENCOURAGED TO REFRAIN FROM FURNISHING THESE REVELATIONS TO ANY OTHER POLICE AGENCY OR NEWS MEDIA UNTIL SUCH TIME AS THE NEW REVELATIONS CAN BE EITHER SUBSTANTIATED OR PROVEN FALSE.

IN ADDITION, HIAU TAKE STEPS TO DETERMINE WHETHER THERE IS ANY PROBABILITY OR POSSIBILITY THAT DE KORENSCHILD'S DEATH COULD HAVE BEEN OTHER THAN SUICIDE.

IMMEDIATE TELETYPE TO FBIHQ CONCERNING EPPSTEIN'S INTERVIEW SHOULD NOT BE DELAYED TO GATHER ADDITIONAL FACTS REGARDING DE KORENSCHILD'S DEATH.
